


Paul A. David: On Path Dependent Acting Agents

Ideal Type Path Dependent

- Level 3: shaping the decision process
- Level 2: containing decision criteria (e.g. Values, norms)
- Level 1: containing action drafts as preversion for later action

meta-patterns: Recognize decision instances / drafts, execute drafts patterns: external instances are good; routines are good; institutions / standards are right drafts action
