Climate change in fragile states

- Good Governance and institutions:
 - conflict sensitive climate change adaptation
 - climate-proof peacebuilding
 - conflict-sensitive low-carbon development
 - adequate assistance for migration

Increased resilience to:

- Climate change
- Violent conflict
- Poverty

> Institutional mechanisms, capacities and structures

- > Awareness, knowledge and skills
- > Legal and regulatory systems - especially management of: land; natural resources: migration
- > Provision of basic services



Bad Governance, Weak

institutions

- Exacerbates impacts of climate change
- Exacerbates pressures on governance
- Weakens already bad government and institutions
- Locks states into repeating cycles of violence



Violent

conflict

- Blocks adaptation
- Holds back development
- Exacerbates social tensions

Interlinkages between climate Alert. change and violent conflict

- Must recognise:
 - a) the social, economic and political consequences of climate change

and

b) that social, economic and political issues influence the impact of climate change on people's lives



Two key requirements:

1.Climate change adaptation is conflict sensitive

2.Peacebuilding and development are climate-proof



Getting the institutions right

- 1. Enhancing institutional flexibility
- 2. Dealing with uncertainty
- 3. Enhancing the knowledge base
- 4. Sequencing
- 5. Strengthening the governance contact



Conclusion

- Addressing climate challenges in FS is challenging, but possible.
- Requires 2 shifts:
 - In how institutions are organised (=> more accountable and transparent)
 - Strategies must adapt to meet combined challenge of climate change, conflict risk and state fragility.
